He also starred as Hades in Paper Mill Playhouse's *Hercules*. He was named New York Magazine's "Stage Performance of the Year" for *The Whale* and is the namesake of the Georgia High School Musical Theatre Awards at Cobb Energy Performing Arts Centre. 




