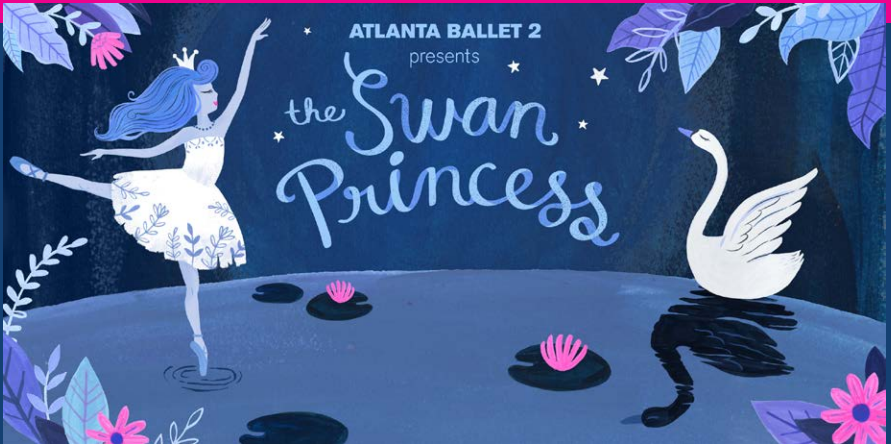
HANSEL AND GRETEL
